1. Place this map on a table, map side up.
2. Fold the paper in half lengthwise
3. With these directions face up fold paper in half widthwise.
4. Fold one open edge to the center fold you just made.
5. Fold the other open edge to the same center fold.
6. Now you have an Accordion Book.

## How to Fold this Map into a Book

- 1. Rio Rancho Public Library, Loma Colorado Br 755 Loma Colorado Blvd NE Rio Rancho 87124 On a hill overlooking a sweeping view of the Rio Grande Valley, the Sandia Mountains and Albuquerque. Relax near windows on east side of the library for a comfortable place to read or reflect and enjoy the vista.
